

Getting to the Woodhill Park Research Retreat

It takes about half an hour from town to get to Woodhill Park in non-peak-hour travel periods. We suggest that you time your trip so that you travel against the traffic both ways. You'll save time and petrol that way.

1. From the city, take the North-western Motorway until the Westgate exit (the final turnoff).
2. Turn left and drive along State Highway 16 towards Helensville.
3. You need to drive through/past Kumeu, Huapai and Waimauku.
4. You'll see what used to be a BP Station on your right at Waimauku (diagonally opposite the turn off to Muriwai Beach and Waimauku School).
5. Continue along State Highway 16 for 1.9 Kilometres and at the top of a large hill, you'll see Woodhill Park Road. (It's on your left even though the road sign is on the right hand side of SH16).
6. Turn down Woodhill Park Road and the Retreat is well sign-posted. It is 560 metres down that road. It's the second house on the right.
7. When you arrive, along with a friendly welcome, a cup of coffee or tea will be either brewed and waiting or will be pending as soon as the kettle has boiled...
